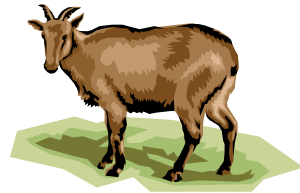


- 15) Kim is half as old as Tim. Tim is 12 years old. How old is Kim?

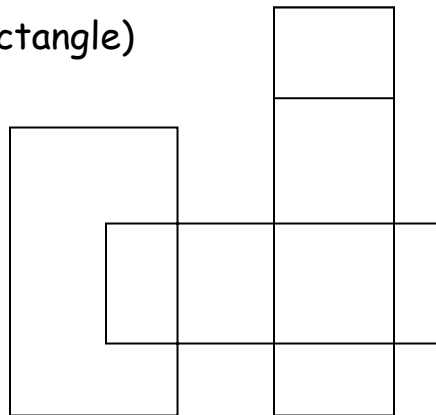


- 18) Quentin has two quarters, Dana has four dimes, Nicholas has 12 nickels and Patricia has 50 pennies. Who has the most money?
