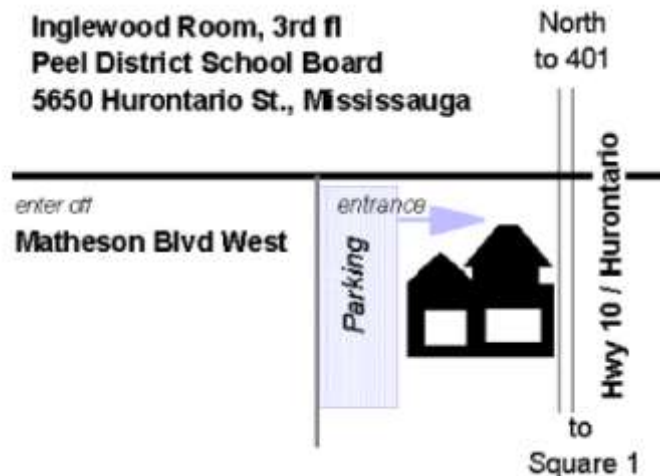
**Cost:** There will be a fee for some of the materials available
