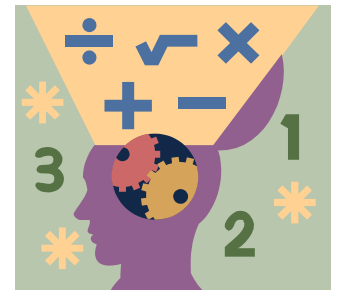


## Parent Night Event

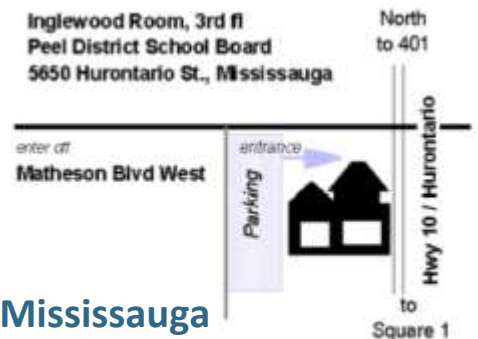
Join us for this interesting review and discussion, addressing the widely varying needs of gifted students.
